for use as a bequest forever

I give to my son John Killion, One Shilling Sterling

I give to my daughter in law Williams Lewin Husband of my daughter Jenni One Shilling Sterling

for Division, Quantity and Quality considered, to gather with One seventh part of all the profits arising from the sale or provision of my unbequeathed Movable Estate and out standing Debts, whom I also appoint one of my Executors of this my last and Testament
