Hello everyone,

Hope all are doing well and staying safe from the Delta variance. Boy, it has still been really very busy with visitors since the release from quarantine; but that's a good thing. I apologize again if some of your emails and/or research request have taken some time and for the website not being updated as timely; I need 5 of me. I am currently attempting to add additional information to the website and finishing up the 3rd Qtr. Newsletter as time permits. Again, our overall goal is to eventually get all our family files, church files and Fairfield County information files uploaded, so that members can do a lot of their research from their home. Remember you can request your family surname to be uploaded ahead of schedule, and I will try to get it done as time permits. I hope everyone is continuing to return to some normalcy. We were able to start back with our in-person meetings in June.

The following is an excerpt from the FCGS Recording Secretary's June Minutes:

The Fairfield County Genealogical Society met on June 21, 2021, at 7 PM in the Great Falls War Memorial Building in Great Falls, SC, for a program on Mount Dearborn and the efforts of the town of Great Falls to establish white-water rafting opportunities in the area. There was a large crowd (61) present with people from Chester, Fairfield, York, and Lancaster counties.

Scott Coleman, a local historian from Chester, originally from Whitmire, SC, presented an excellent and informative program on Mount Dearborn and the many people associated with it. Mount Dearborn is located on an island in the Catawba River in Chester County. It was initially conceived and selected by President George Washington to be one of the nation's three national arsenal -armories. Years later Congress proposed that a regional military academy be opened there as well. In 1802 at the urging of U.S. Senator Thomas Sumter, Secretary of War Henry Dearborn purchased 523 acres near the village of Rocky Mount. The secretary for whom the site was named, employed Eli Whitney to consult with state engineer, Christian Senf, on the best location to build on the new land. Part of the plan included the construction of a canal that would be a source of waterpower. By early 1804 construction began on the magazine and arsenal, but the armory was never constructed. Coleman told how many prominent South Carolinians were associated with the site. He also mentioned Rocky Mount, which is in Fairfield County, and was the site of one of Fairfield county's Revolutionary War skirmishes.

Glinda Price Coleman is executive director of the Great Falls Hometown Association, which is a non-profit focusing on economic and community development for Great Falls and the surrounding area. She presented a program on white-water rafting courses that are being developed in conjunction with Mount Dearborn. She also talked about plans for the Mount Dearborn tract of land to be made into a state park. Another segment of her program was the trail the GFHTA and the town are working to build which will be a part of the Carolina Thread Trail, a regional network of trails with eleven counties in North Carolina and four counties in South Carolina including Chester.

The following is an excerpt from the FCGS Recording Secretary's July Minutes:

- We welcomed our special guest for today, Major Melvin Whittenburg, a retired major from the U.S. Army and now a resident of Winnsboro. Major Melvin Whittenburg gave some observations about living in Winnsboro. He said he was delighted to live in a small town and wanted to see it take advantage of its varied history and outstanding architecture of its homes and public buildings. He wants to see the town grow and bring in new revenue. He thinks the town needs to be more visible and mentioned lack of signage on the interstate. He thinks Winnsboro should capitalize on being listed in the National Register of Historic Places. There is a need for new stores in Winnsboro as well as recreational opportunities. A passport book was mentioned and the possibility of working with other genealogical societies to bring in more tourists. Mary Anne Oliver mentioned pickle ball and disc golf as possible recreational opportunities. Donnie Laird suggested getting Gene Stephens of the Chamber of Commerce to talk to the group about how the genealogical might assist.
- Isabelle Killian is the recipient of the Fairfield County Genealogical Society scholarship. She is an honor graduate of Dutch Fork High School.
- Announcements: Please see the announcements for upcoming meetings/programs and national webinars.
- Check the web site for possible upcoming meetings in August and September. Currently, there are no plans for these meetings. There will be no meeting in October due to the Coleman-Feaster-Mobley Reunion. President Killian is working to get several authors to the Reunion. Among these are Pat Veasey, Brent Holcomb, and Mary Ann Ladd (new Catherine Ladd book). The Fairfield County Historical Society will have a table. Pelham Lyles said there will be no Lyles Reunion this year. Plans call for an annual meeting in November. There will probably be a Christmas gala in early December at the museum and there may be a genealogical society Christmas party.
- Free Mason Exhibit at the museum organized by Ed Gates. Pelham Lyles noted how thorough and complete the exhibit covers the subject.
- Mary Anne Oliver noted that The North of Ireland Family History Society will host a DNA Summer School to be held from 6th to 10th of September by Zoom. Mary Anne Oliver will send the information to Eddie Killian, and he will post it on the Fairfield County Genealogical Society web site.
- Nancy Hoy reported there are 100,393 names in the Fairfield County Families data base. There are 1354 members in the Fairfield County DNA project.

We continue to thank new and past volunteers for their membership and support!

Again, thank you, for the continued giving of old, discarded library books, old Bibles, and research materials that help enhance the research library collection and expedite research request resolution. These items are coming from estates, libraries, member's collections, and other sources. We are a non-profit and can provide a receipt upon request.
