DIRECTIONS: From Interstate 77, exit onto Blythewood Road (Exit 27). Head toward US 21. At the traffic light (a T-intersection at US 21), turn left onto US 21 and in a rather short distance, turn right onto Langford Road. Cross over railroad tracks. You will see the George Peter Hoffman House on the left (171 Langford Road) Travel along Langford Road for approximately 4 miles. Turn left onto Grover Wilson Road. (If you see Hardscrabble Road to the right, you have gone a little too far.) Travel approximately .09 miles on Grover Wilson Road, then turn right onto Zion Church Road. (Look closely, there is a road sign but it may be obscured by foliage.) Follow Zion Church Road, approximately 1.1 miles. Just after you go around a big curve, you will see the church on the right.
