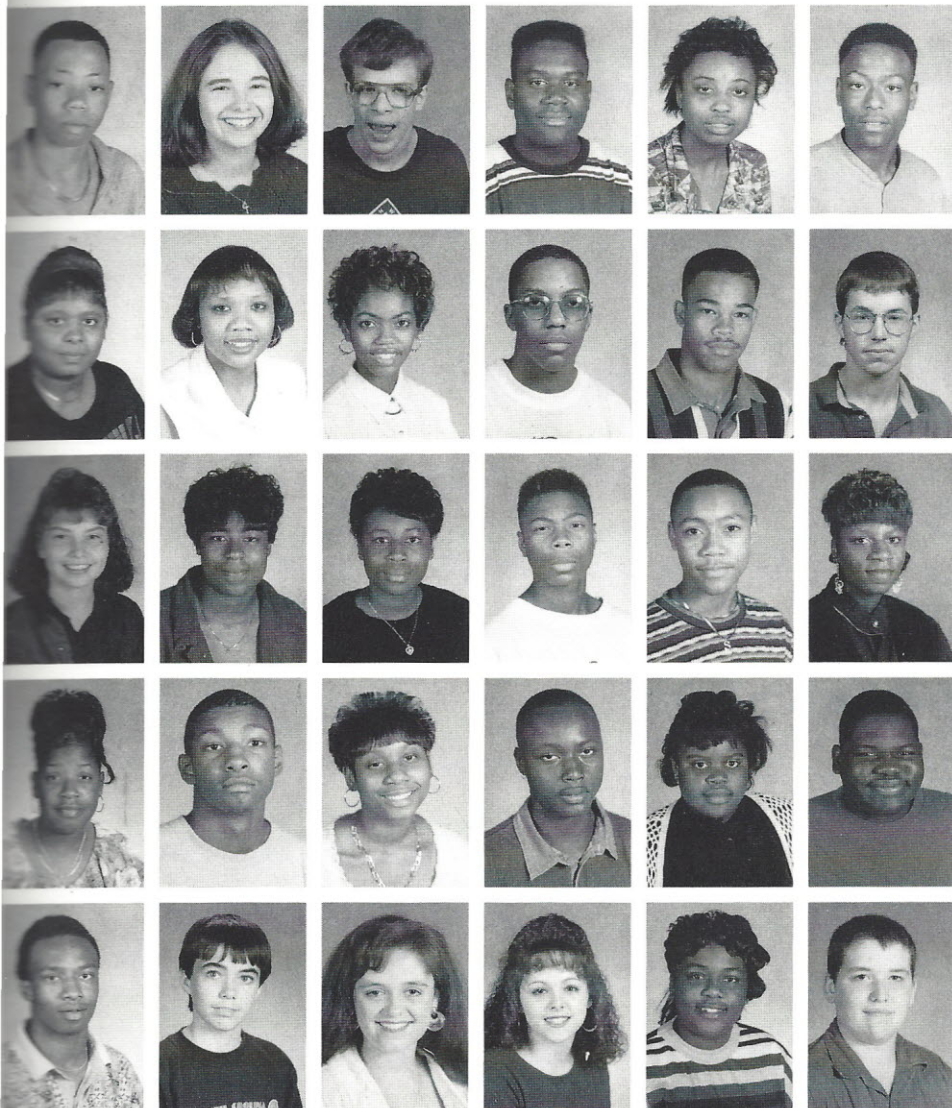


"A Different View"
