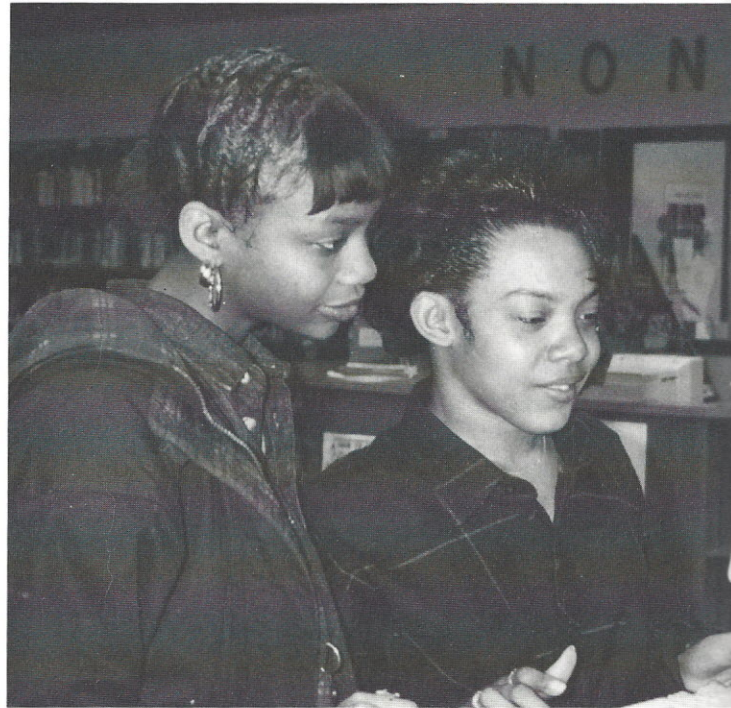
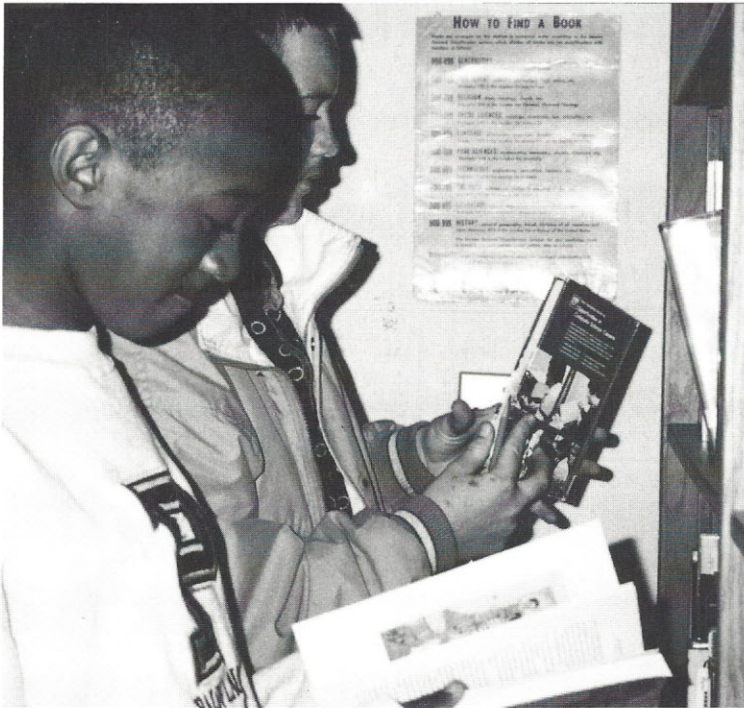


The Help Center



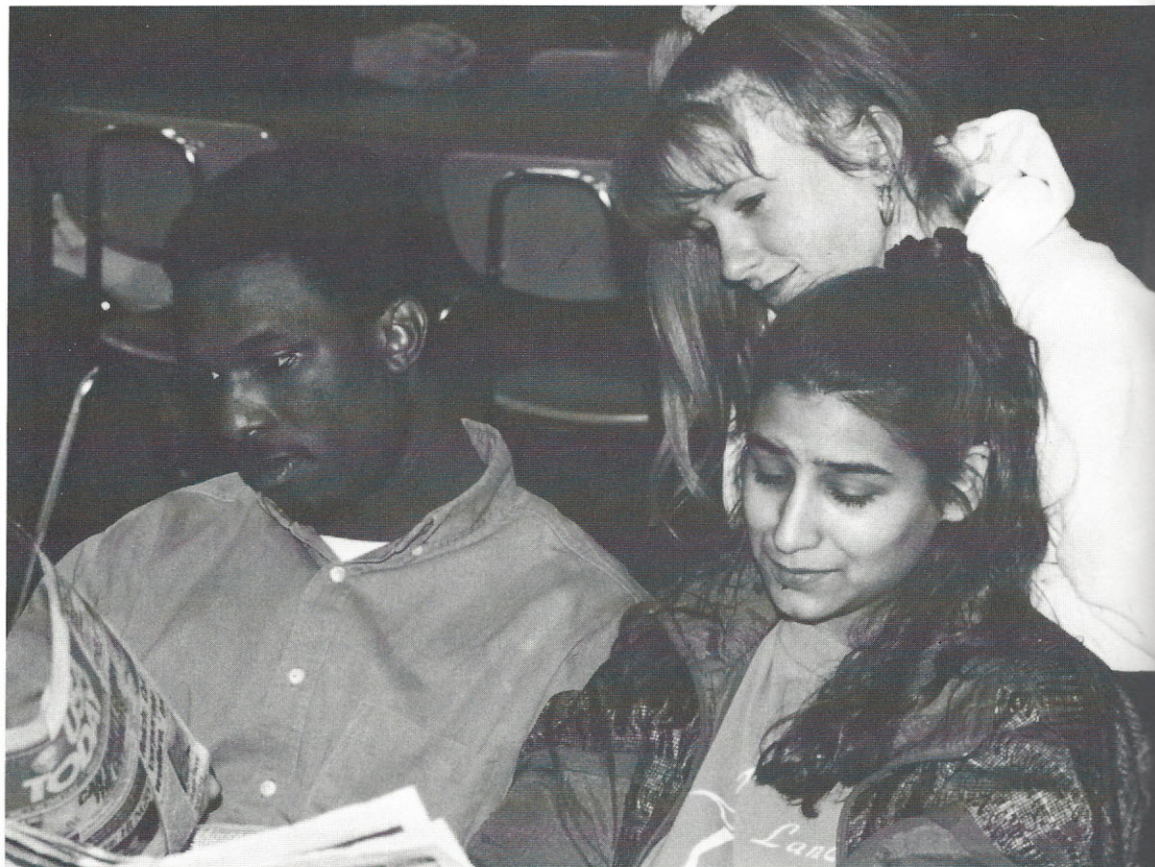
Brian Branham guides his friend through the Dewey Decimal System in the library.
