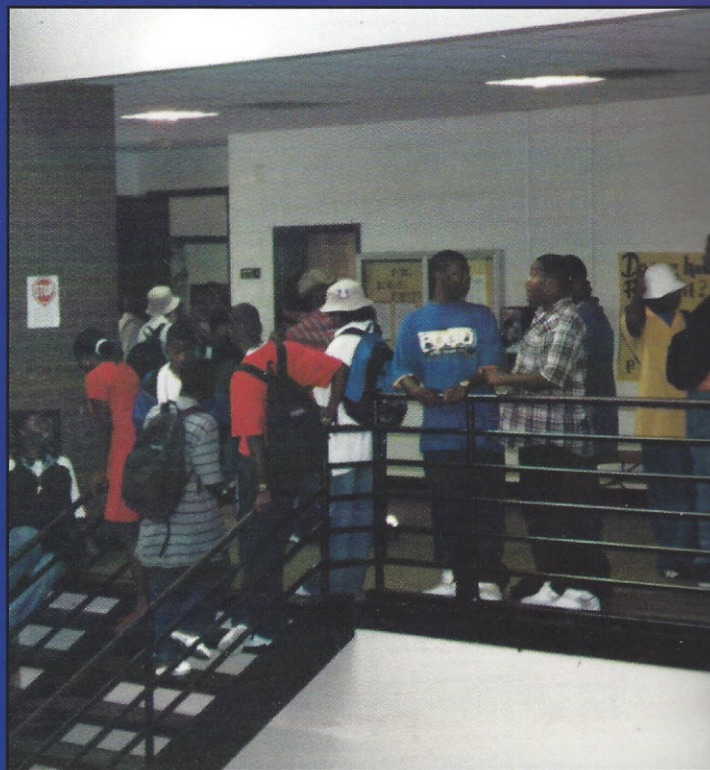


A Typical Griffin Day: Before School
