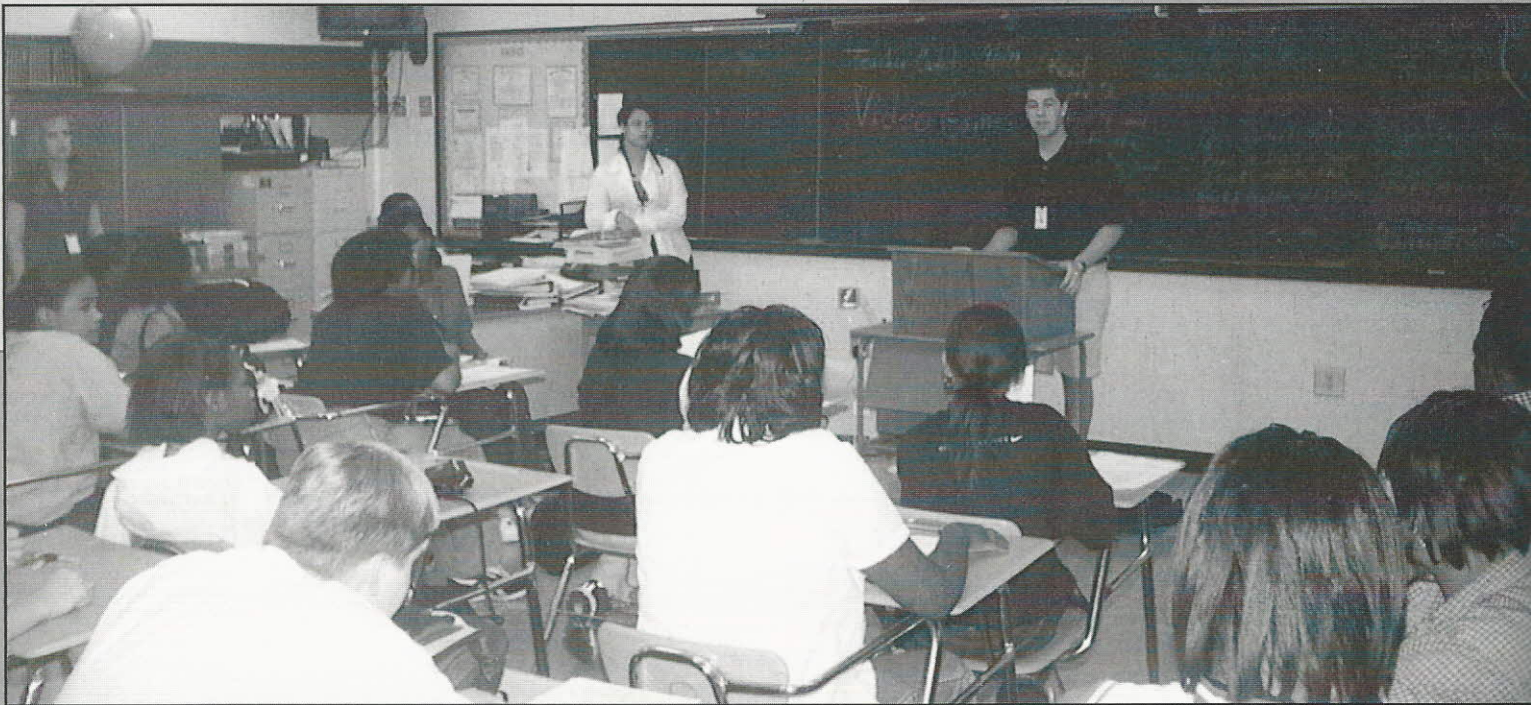
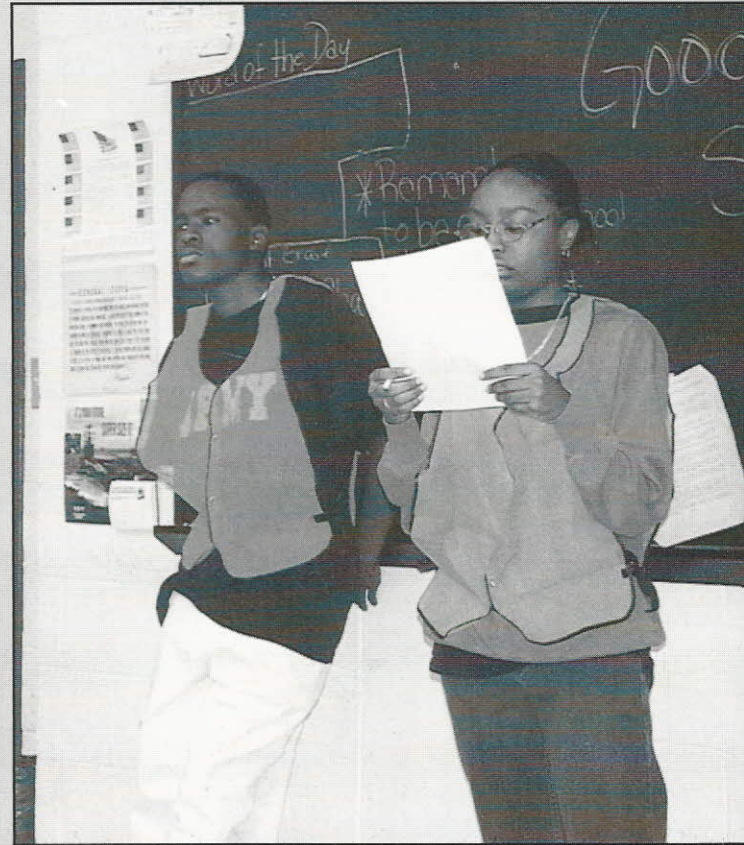


Debate Club
