Congratulations upon the publication of the first yearbook of Fairfield Jr. High. Even though this is only the second year of existence of our school, we can see the results of having worked and planned together.

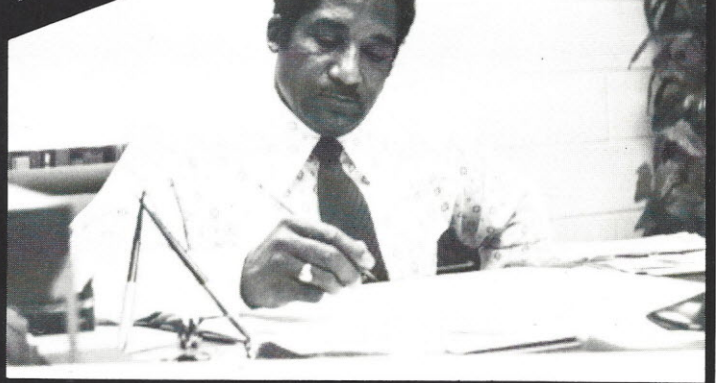

Before working with Fairfield County Schools, he was Superintendent of Lexington County District number 4. Mr. Goff has been with Fairfield County for four years now.



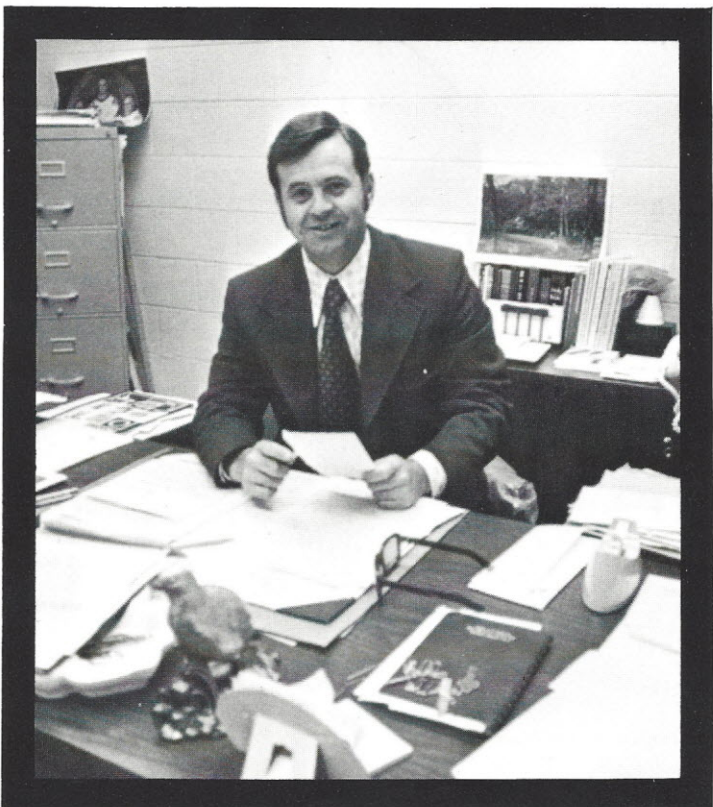

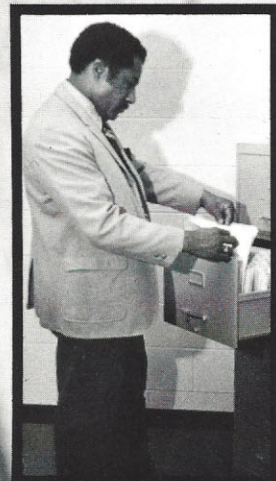




H. M. Sims, Principal

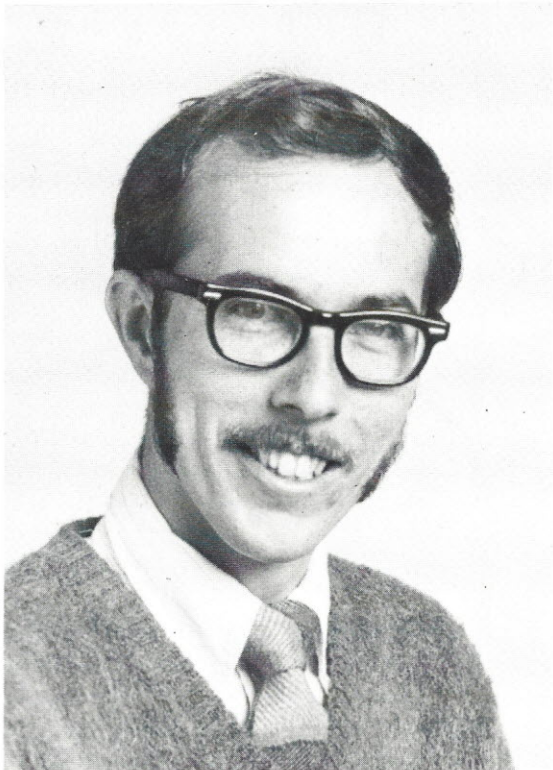
Mr. Batten attended Western Carolina University and the University of South Carolina. He has a M. E. D. degree.

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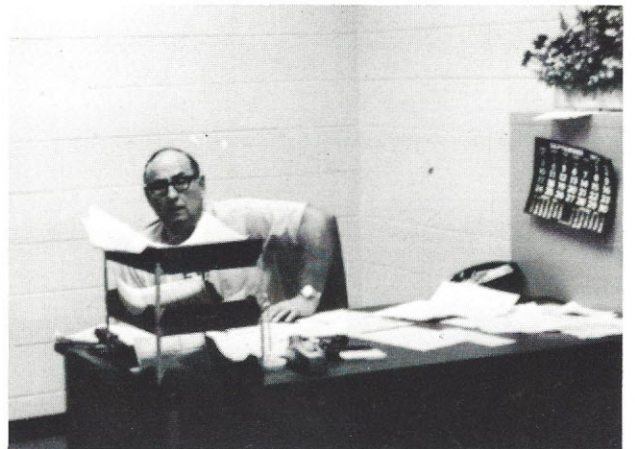
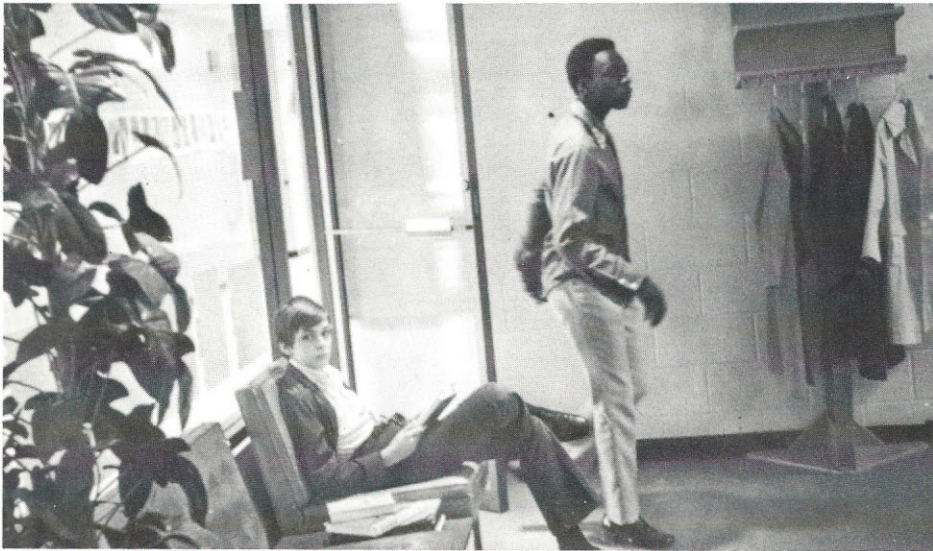
Frederick (Rick) A. Tanner, A. A., B. A., M. A. T.

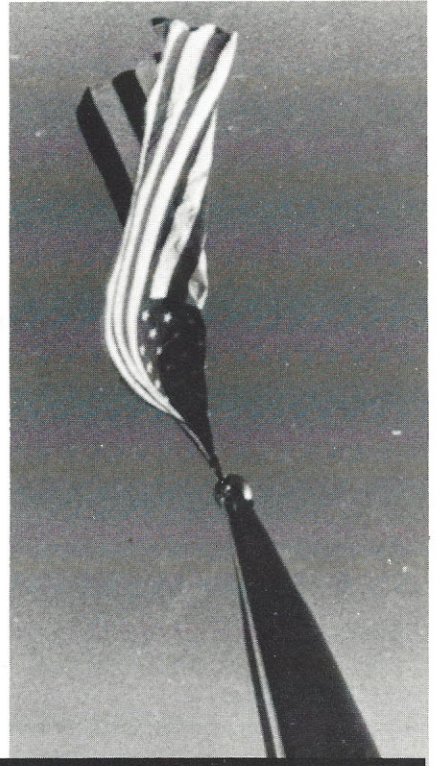
The lunchroom staff of Fairfield Junior High has done a fine job in serving the students. Under the supervision of Mrs. Viola Kennedy, they have prepared lunches that are both nourishing and delicious. Mrs. Kennedy says they prepare lunches with type A nutritional goals. Each worker is assigned to a certain job in the cafeteria, and trys hard to satisfy the students as well as teachers. In each meal they try to include all of the following:

1. One half pint of milk as a beverage to provide most of calcium and other nutrients.
2. Two ounces protein-rich foods for normal growth and for building and repair of the body.
3. 3/4 cut vegetables and fruits consisting of two or more vegetables or fruits, or both.
4. One serving of whole-grain or enriched bread; or a serving of other bread such as cornbread, biscuits, rolls or muffins.
5. Two teaspoons of butter or fortified margerine to provide some of the calories and Vitamin A.

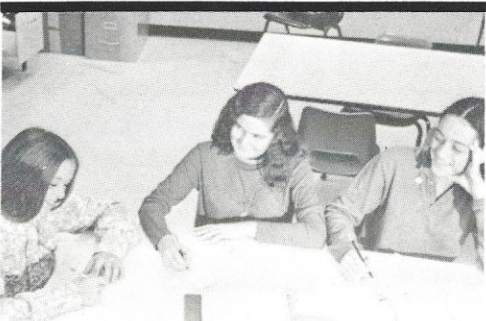
The type A lunch nutritional goal include: A vitamin C food each day. A vitamin A food twice a week.

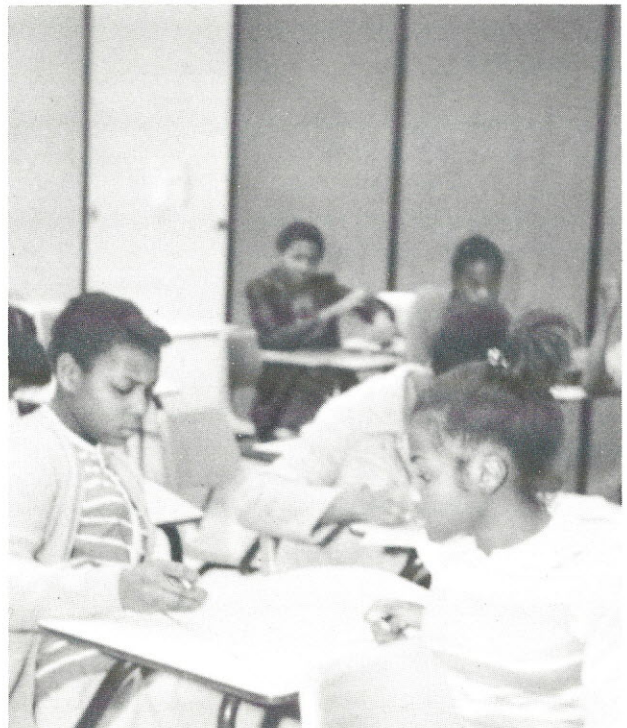
DRAMATICS

Nixon has endured and triumphed. Today he stands before one of the largest majorities ever given to a presidential candidate, he bestrides a political landscape carved out in his own image.

The resounding success of Clifford Irving's talk show, his peripatetic collaboration with Howard Hughes, has all but obscured the general fascination with the baleful billionaire himself.

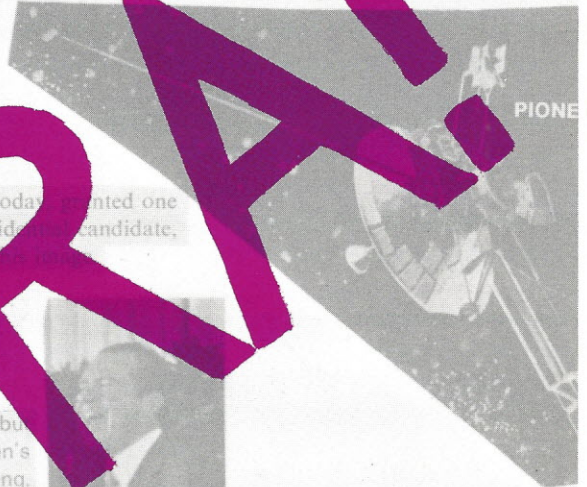
It may not quite be the Year of the Woman, but neither is this election season the women's movement going to go away. For the running, sometimes a precedent start in the late 1960s, the struggle for equality has caught in the national mind.

With President Nixon's week from China, two pictures seemed to be taken during an extraordinary venture. One was taken during a banquet in Hangchow, which amplified the open warmth and amiability marking the public contacts between the Americans and their host, Chinese Premier Chou En-lai. The other, taken as Chou listened to Nixon speak (left), pointed up the private differences. Widely different needs and interests still separate the U.S. and China, and they were especially apparent as the presidential party returned home.

Through a desolate landscape of dried mud, stagnant water and gutted homes, the children of the Wilkes-Barre area in Pennsylvania's Wyoming Valley tramped back to school last week. They were 14 days late, but at least they were there. Last June, tropical storm Agnes left over 13,000 Valley families homeless and caused more than a billion dollars in property damage.

The Munich Games started in splendor, stopped in blood, and limped to a close in a jumble of anger, disillusion and blame-throwing. The tragic murder of the Israelis overshadowed everything, but the other confusion was profound enough to raise real questions about the future of the Games.

Late next week, a modest, spindly looking craft will pass a major milestone on a journey out into space than any man-made object ever gone. After crossing the orbit of Mars, by the previous computer limit, Pioneer 10 will go on through the asteroid Belt, making observations there and all the while hurtling toward its mission: the planet Jupiter.

Art is not an asset, but a necessity to a good school program. It motivates students, provides an outlet for emotions, instills a feeling of success and pride that can only result from creative expression.

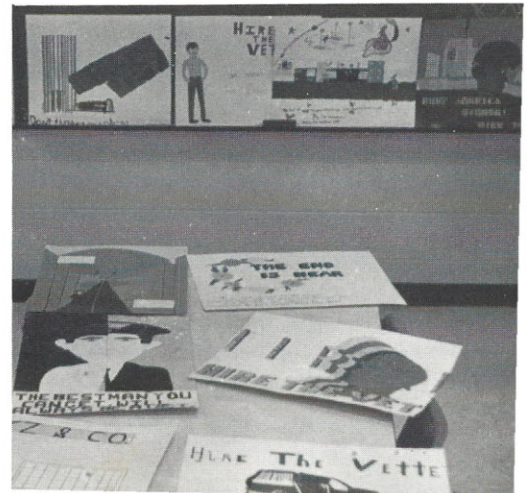

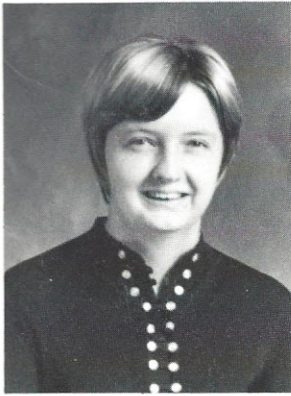
In October, art students visited the annual Crafts Fair at Gatlinburg, Tenn. This Crafts Fair is the largest in the United States.



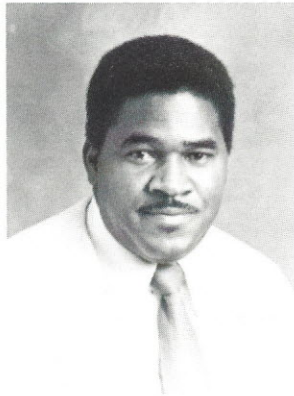

Unfortunately, a necessary part of cooking is washing the dishes. Home Economics students do have a fringe benefit though - they get to eat what they cook.

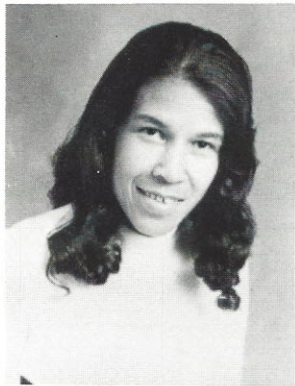
