



SUPERINTENDENT


Mr. Goff attended Clemson, University of South Carolina, and Columbia College. He has a B.S. degree from Clemson and a Masters degree from U.S.C.


Before working with Fairfield County Schools, he was Superintendent of Lexington County District number 4. Mr. Goff has been with Fairfield County for five years now.




Mr. Stone has an A.B. from Erskine and a Master's Degree from the University of South Carolina. He also has work leading to a doctorate degree.

MR. A. CLARK BATTEN


COORDINATOR TITLE III EESA


