The Good Neighbor Policy.**

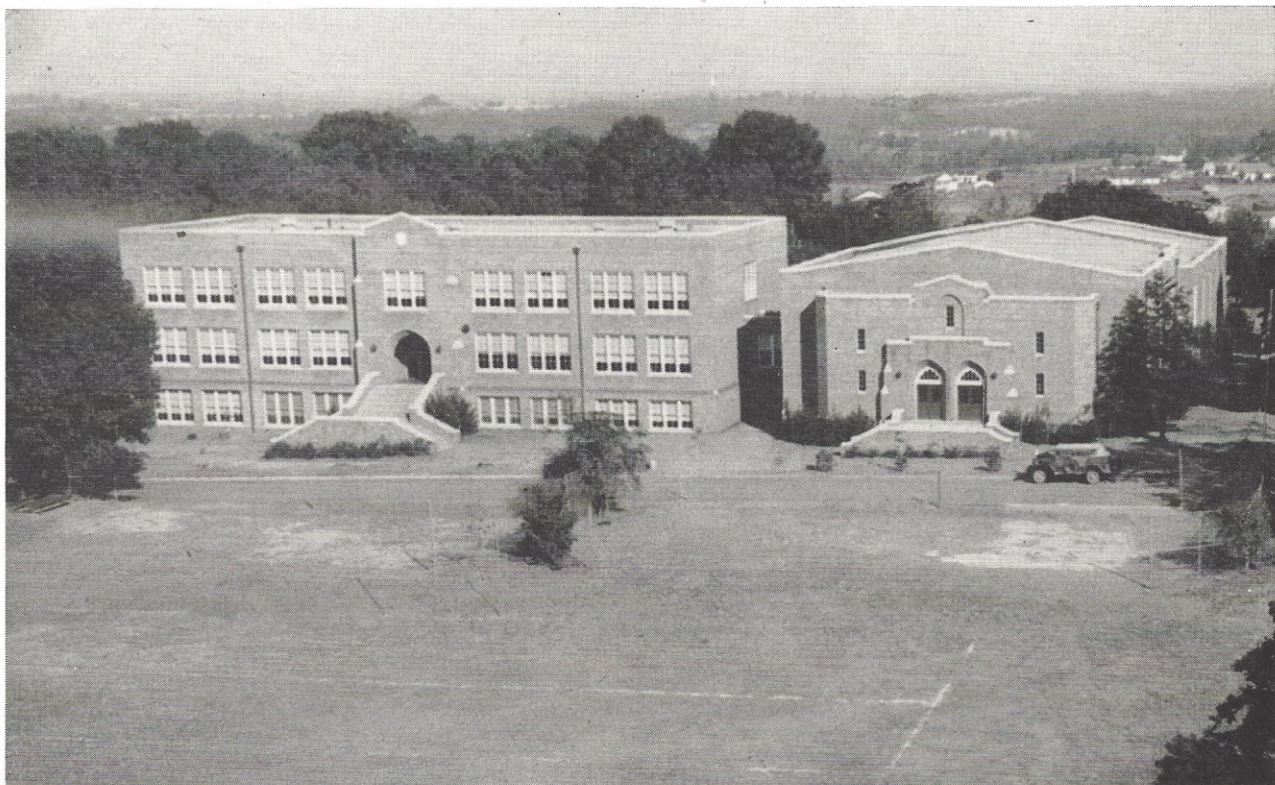


DEDICATION
