



Soto voce . . . pretty eyes . . . wears pencil behind ear . . . dependable . . . sailor stride . . . new edition of encyclopedia.


ANNIE ESTELLE MCCLINTOCK

I always think they're educated but you know better. I love Margie.



MARGIE CAROLYN MCCRIGHT
