The Park was named in honor of Fortune, a slave of Captain John Buchanan, who is said to have waited on La Fayette during the American Revolution. His master granted him his freedom and the tract of land. When Fortune died, the town of Winnsboro took possession of the tract of land since Fortune had no heirs. The Park has a beautiful reflection pool, swimming pool, recreation hall and National Guard Armory.
