

# Fairfield County Courthouse



The Fairfield County Courthouse was built in 1822 by William McCreight under the supervision of Robert Mills, a South Carolina architect who was then serving as Superintendent of Public Works. Alterations and additions to the Courthouse were made in 1844. The building was renovated in 1939 with the addition of two rear wings and the flying stairways in front by G. Thomas Harmon, AIA, as supervising architect.
