THE FINAL GAME

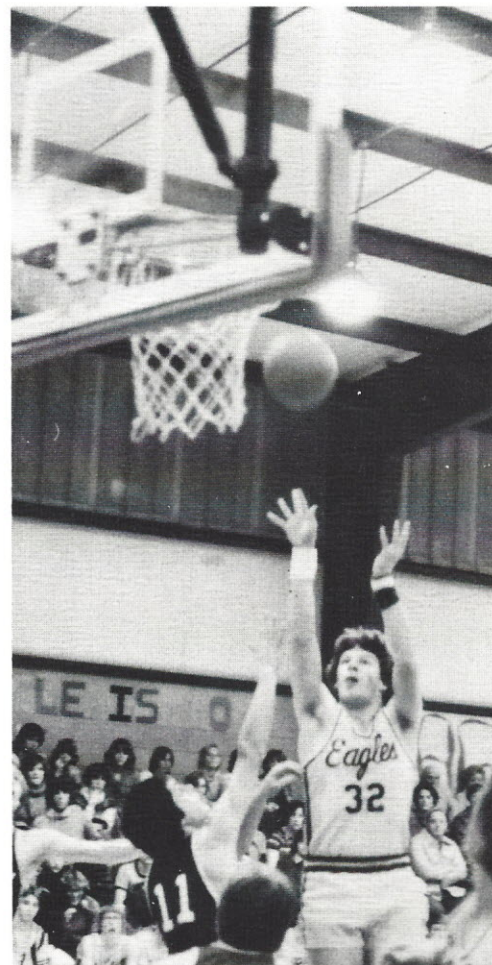
We know You call the plays, Lord,
