

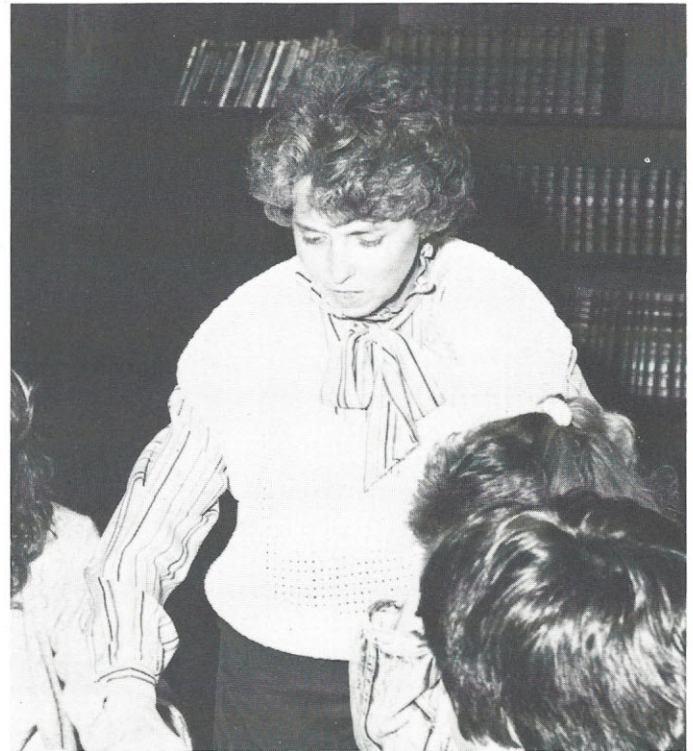
# Humanities in Spotlight
