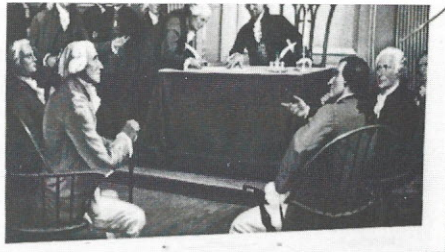


We, the children of 1-B,
