Consisting of 114 students, grades K-3 through 5th make up Richard Winn's "lower school." Days are filled with numbers and letters on various levels. First grade teacher, Mrs. Harden, and second grade teacher, Mrs. Wright, have resource rooms set up to make available to our youngsters "hands-on" experiences in math and science. Third graders anticipate learning cursive handwriting and South Carolina history while fourth and fifth graders enjoy being more independent in their studies.

For extracurricular activities these children are instructed in music, art, computer, and library. This year parents have volunteered to assist in instructing P.E. one day each week. It is this type of dedication along with that of their teachers that makes the lower school as sound as it is — thus producing the high school students of

tomorrow.
