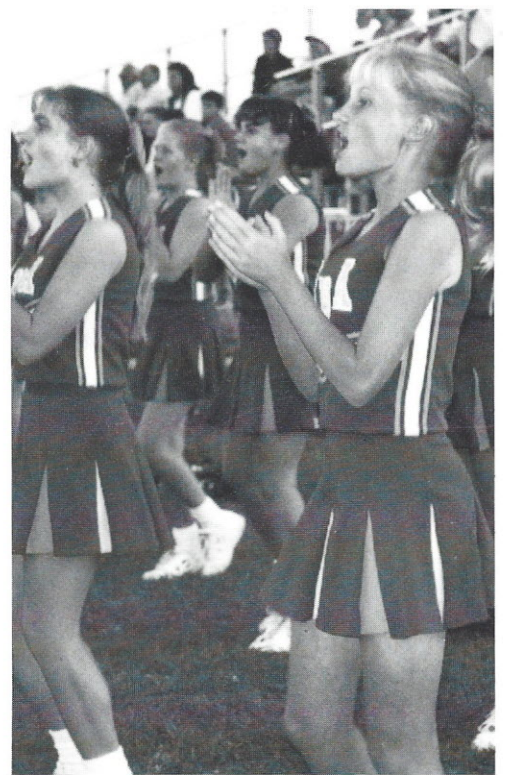


Enthusiasm Counts
