

1968. Under the leadership of Headmaster William DuBard, Pelham Lyles (Spong) is RWA's first graduate as the second school year comes to a close. RWA also fields its first girls' and boys' basketball teams this year.

1970. Three graduating seniors are awarded diplomas on the grounds of the new "still under construction" school at its present location. In September, classes open in the new facility with a record of 247 students.

1969. Mr.S.D. Cathcart donates land on Old Chester Rd. to accommodate the new school building being planned and constructed for the growing enrollment. As the years pass, more land is acquired to expand even more.

1971. Varsity baseball is added to the extracurricular activities. Due to the popularity and support of the basketball program, plans are drawn up to add a gymnasium to the new school facility.
