"I would keep it and give it back to the person who lost it." — Mary Bunting

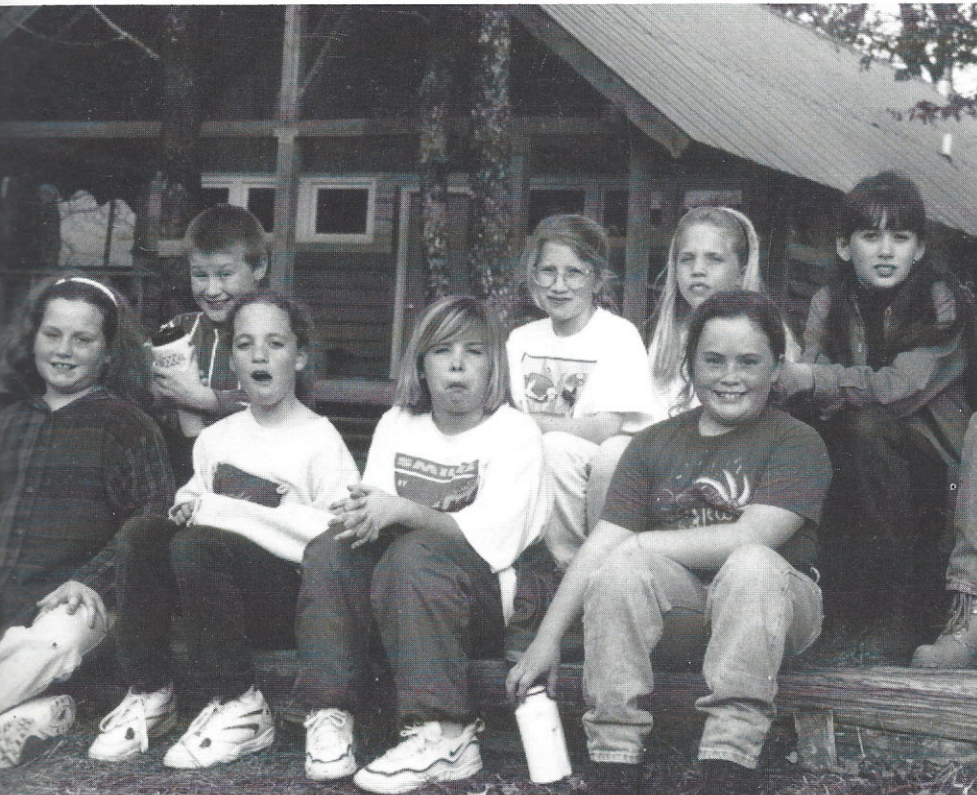
"I'd donate it all to the homeless." — Joshua McCleary
