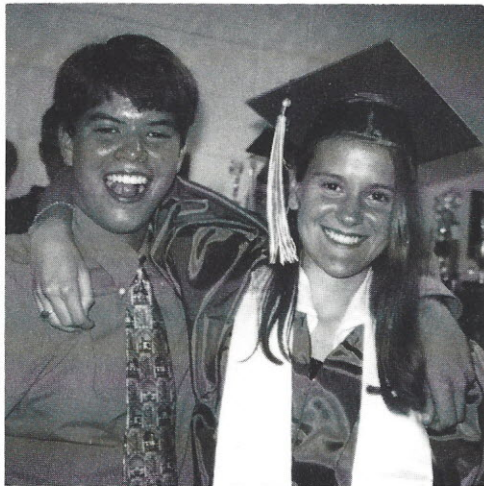


AHEAD OF OUR TIME.

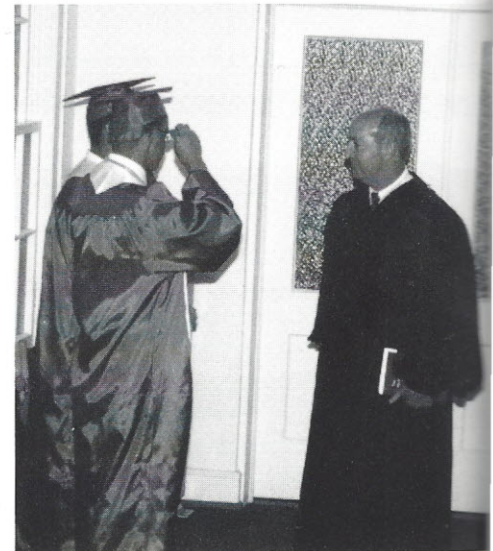
