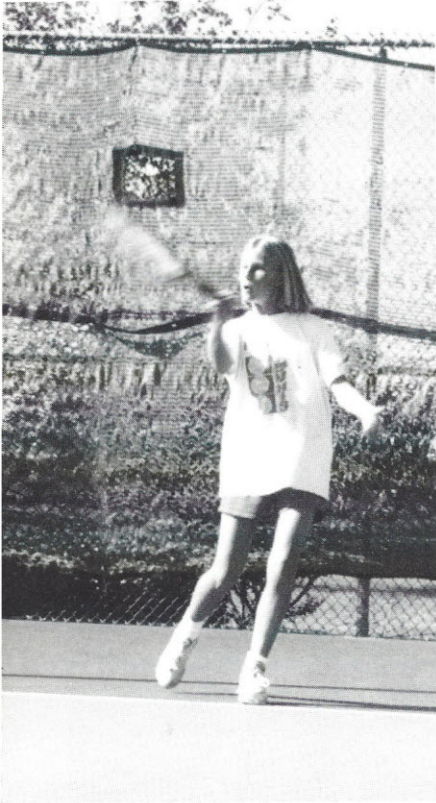


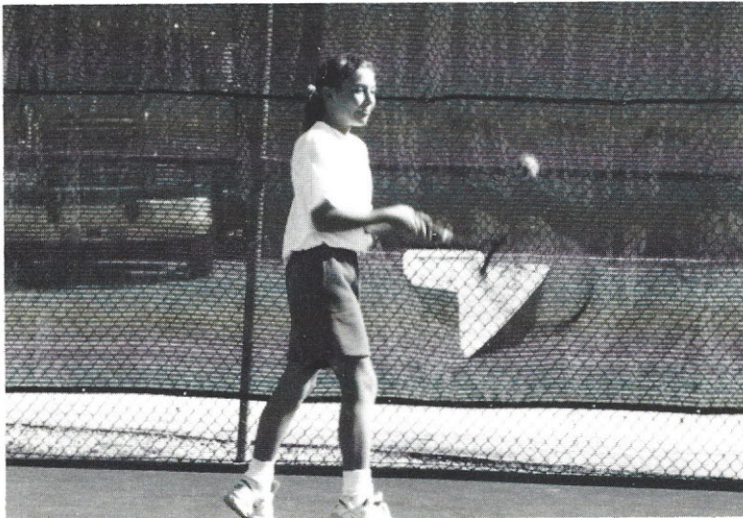
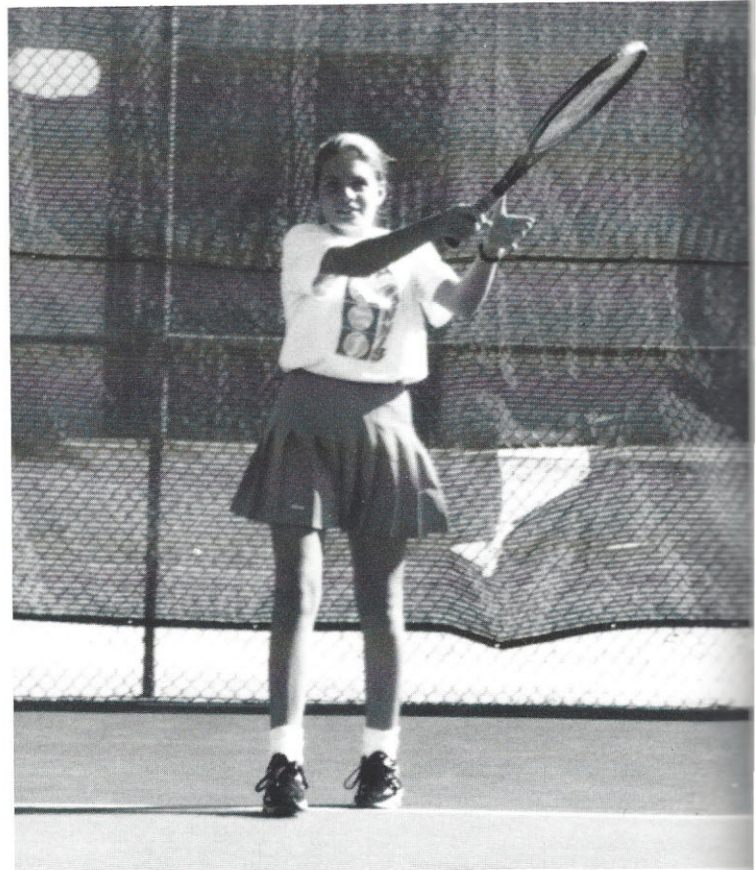
FUTURE WINNERS
