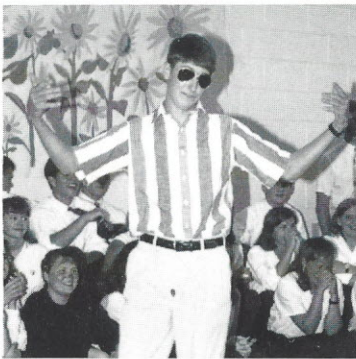




# TIME'S UP
