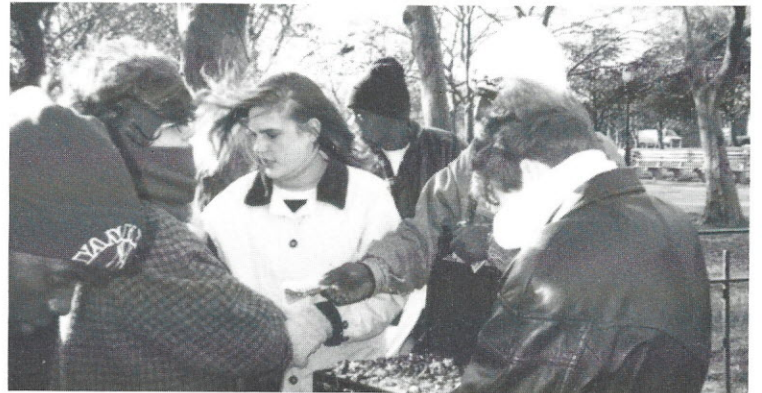
THE BIG APPLE. An aerial view of New York City is taken from the plane as it begins to land. For the first time on the trip the students were quieted by the amazing view from the windows.
