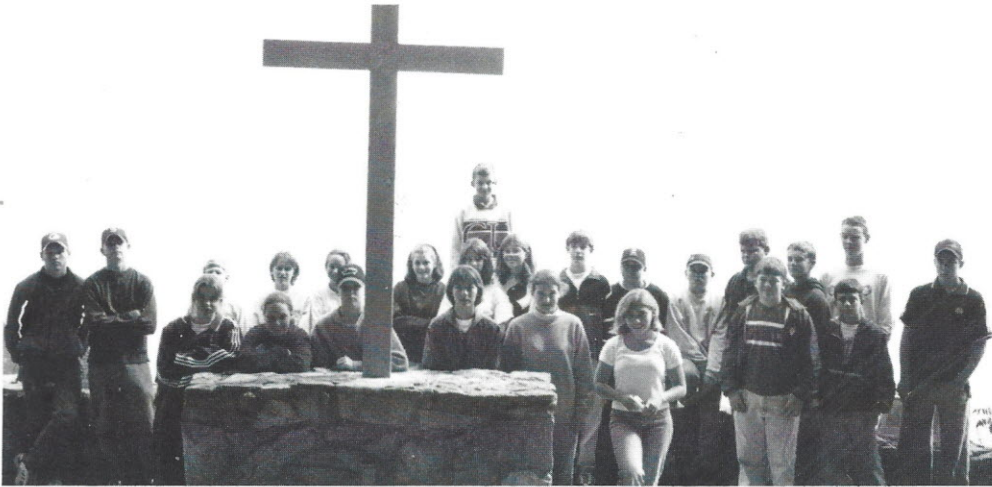


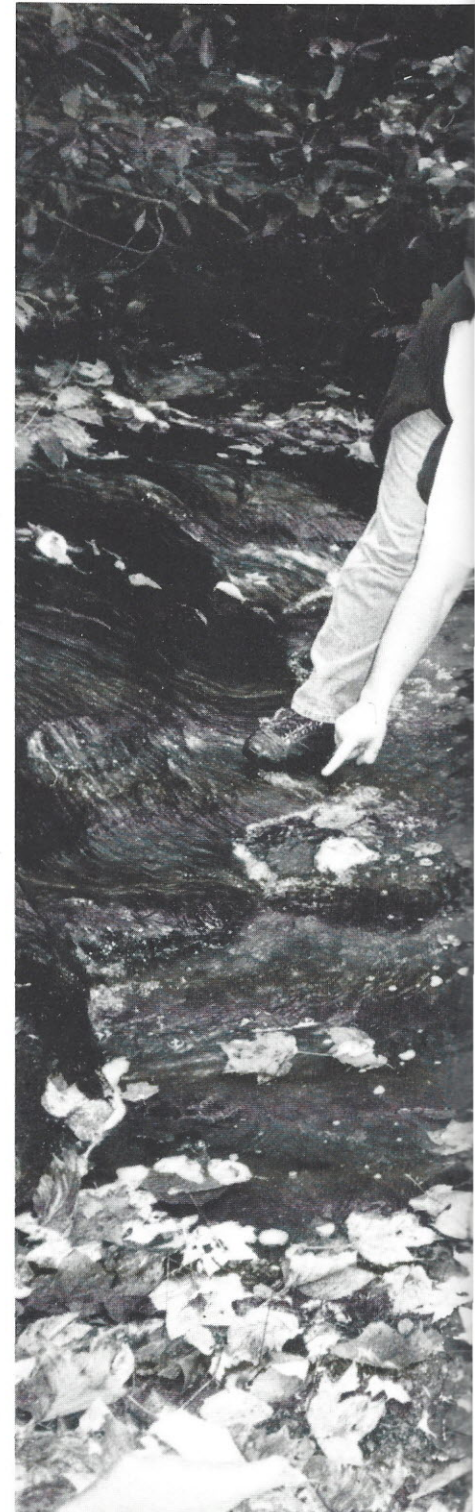
EIGHTH GRADERS EXPLORE
