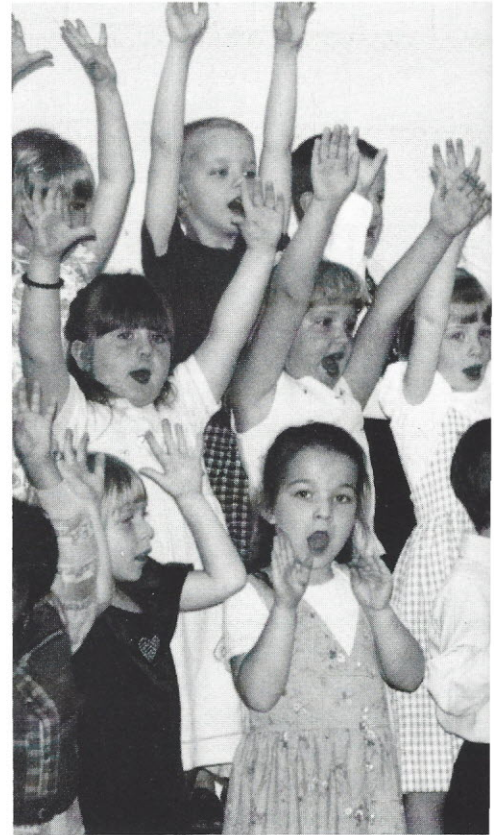


**COSTUME PARTY?** No, it's not Halloween, it's time for the first grade play program. These first graders had lots of fun dressing up and performing before their family members and friends.



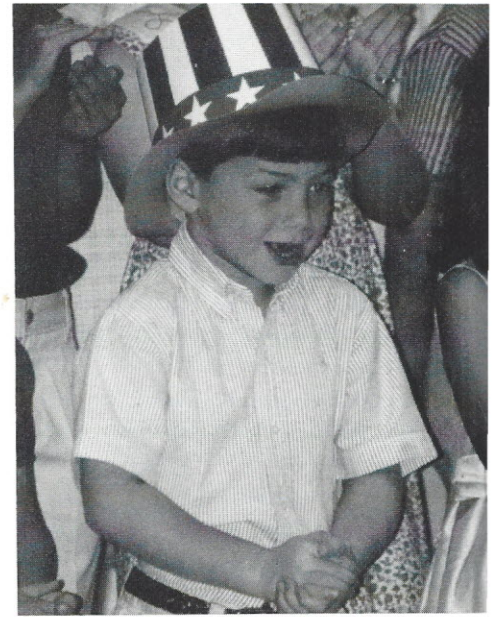
