RWA juniors, seniors, and guests join hands as they circle the dance floor during Prom night. This glamorous evening was a memorable event in the lives of all who attended.

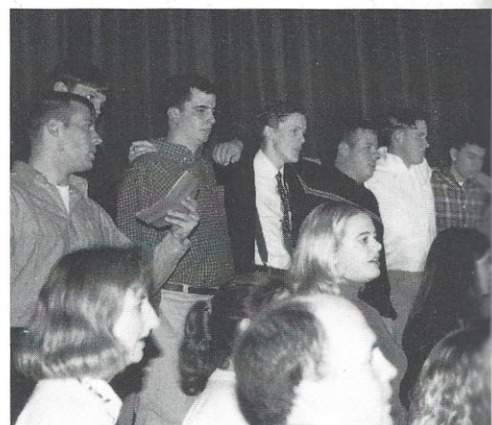
YOUNG ENTHUSIASM...
