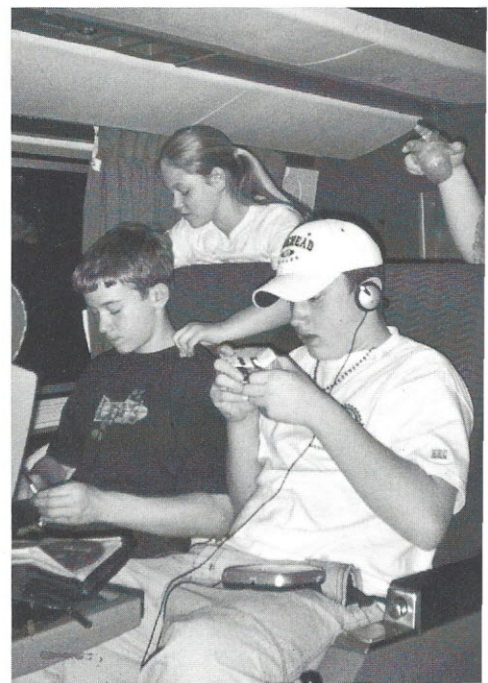
A KODAK MOMENT
