

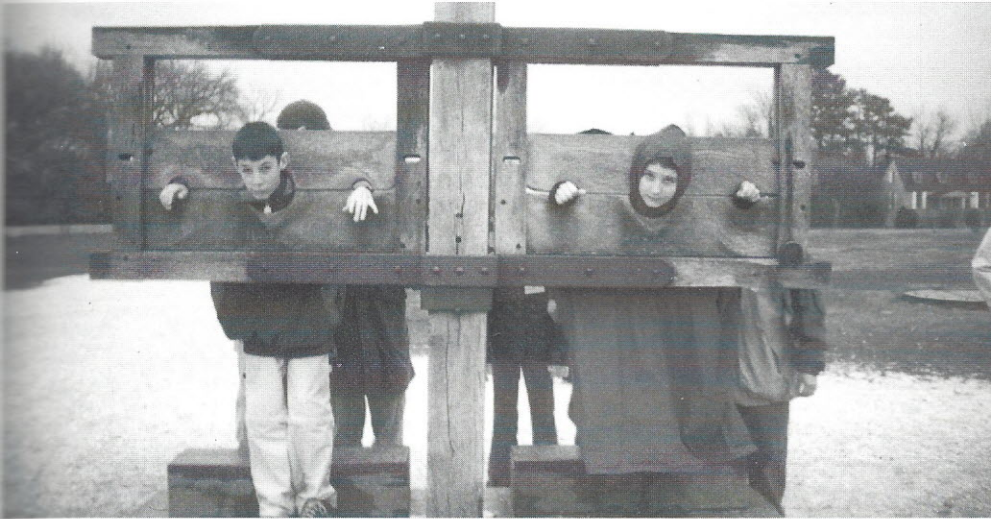


STEPPING BACK INTO HISTORY

The sixth grade class poses in front of Monticello, Thomas Jefferson's impressive mountaintop home. This was one of the last and favorite stops on their trip.

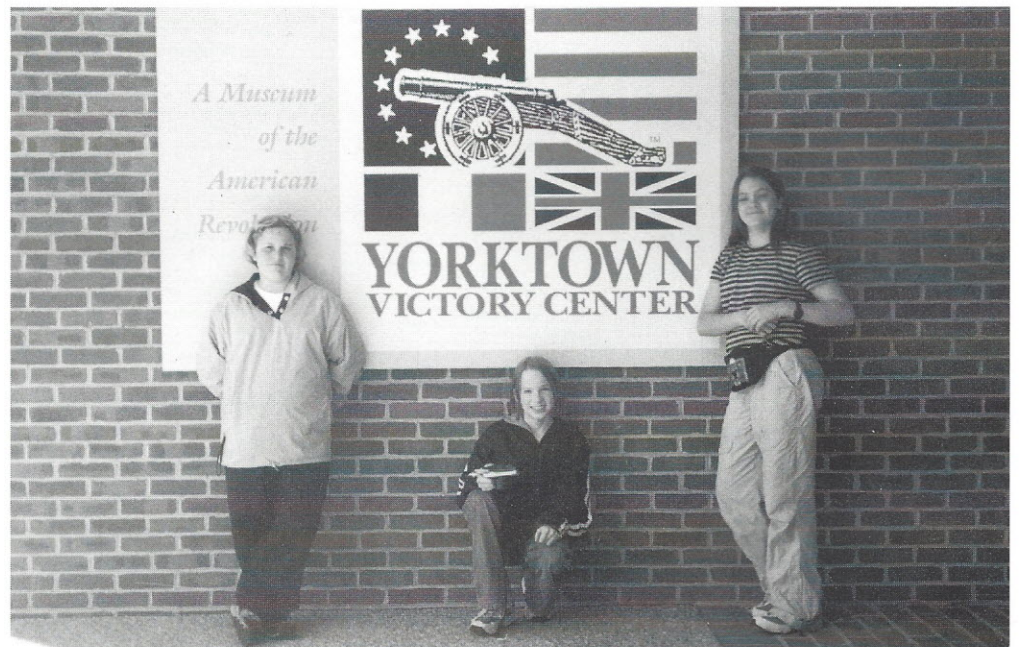
CALL OF THE WILD
