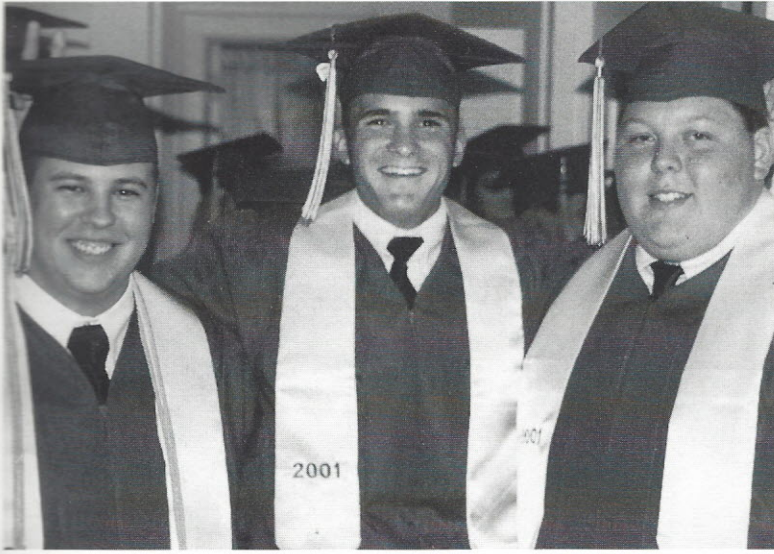


THE THREE AMIGOS

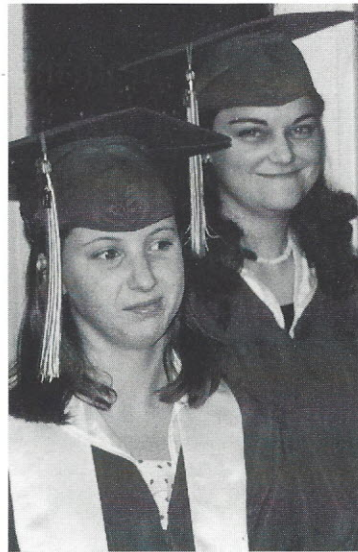
YES, WE MADE IT!
