

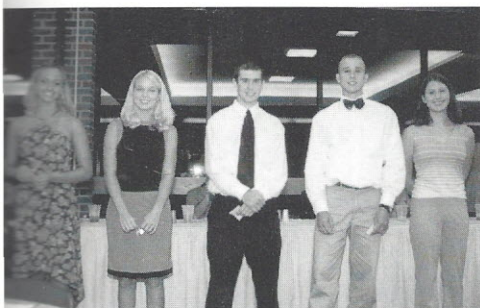
WHAT AN HONOR!

Brice Porter informs everyone at the banquet of her goals as she progresses toward the future. Brice served as vice-president of the Junior Beta Club.



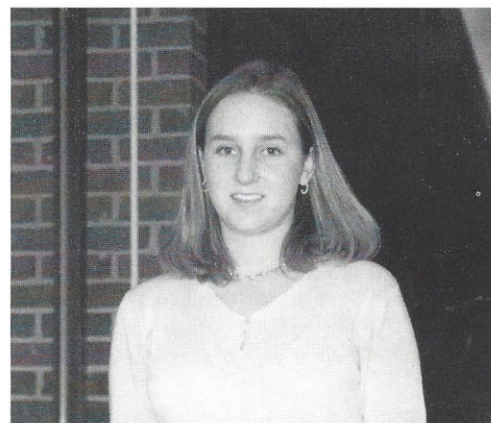

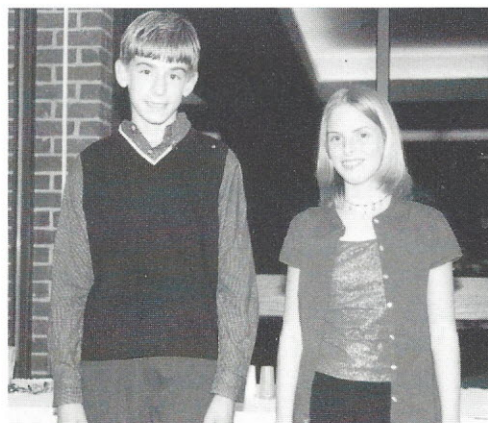

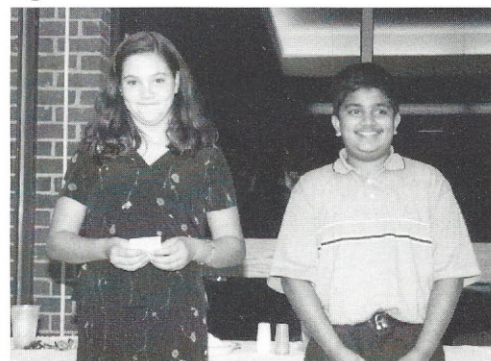
