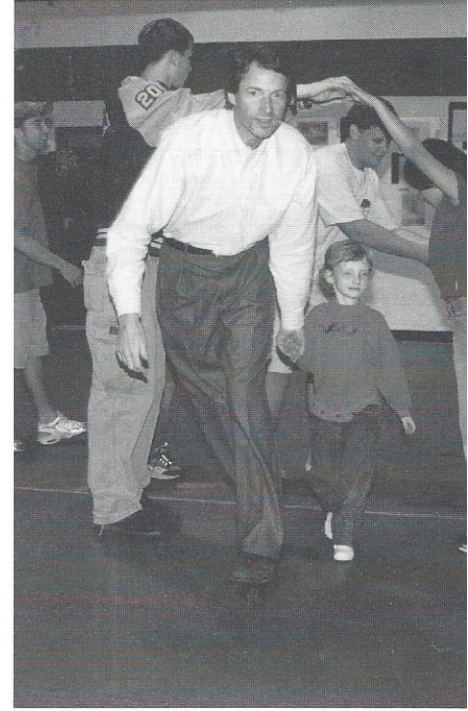
SLIDE ON THROUGH...

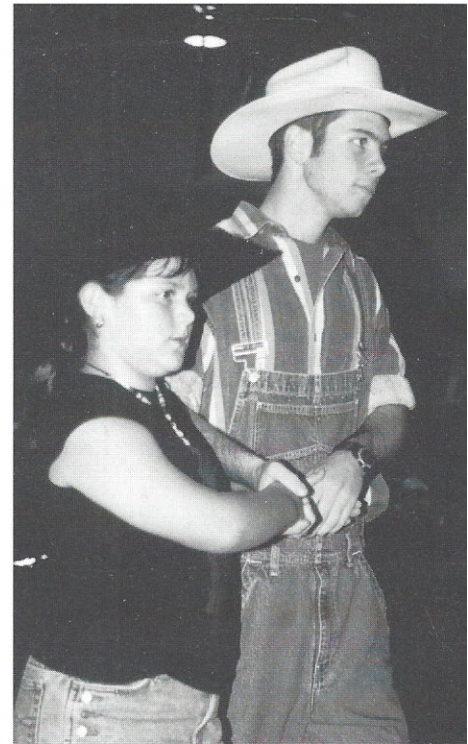
A FAMILY AFFAIR...
