

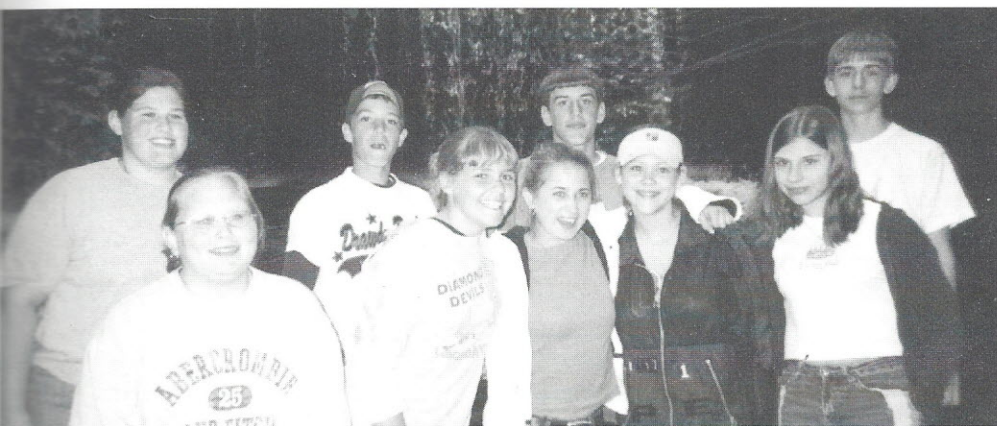


HIKING UP THE MOUNTAIN . . .
