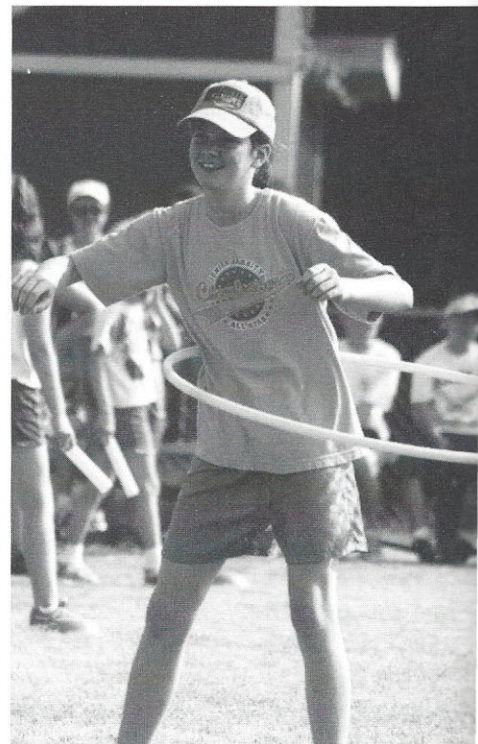


MMM GOOD...
