• SINGING LOUD AND PROUD! •

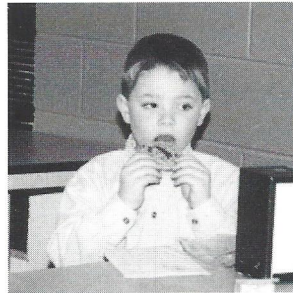
During the annual Thanksgiving program, Caitlin Case performs a solo part. Caitlin and her classmates worked hard for Ms. Livings to learn the music and sing well.



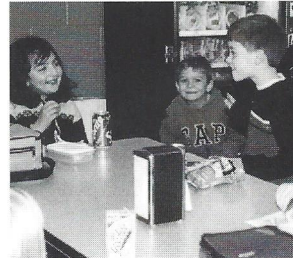

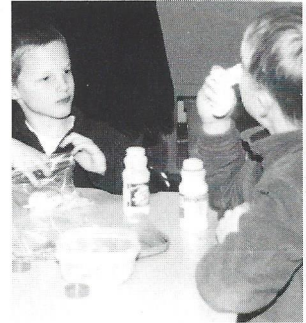
