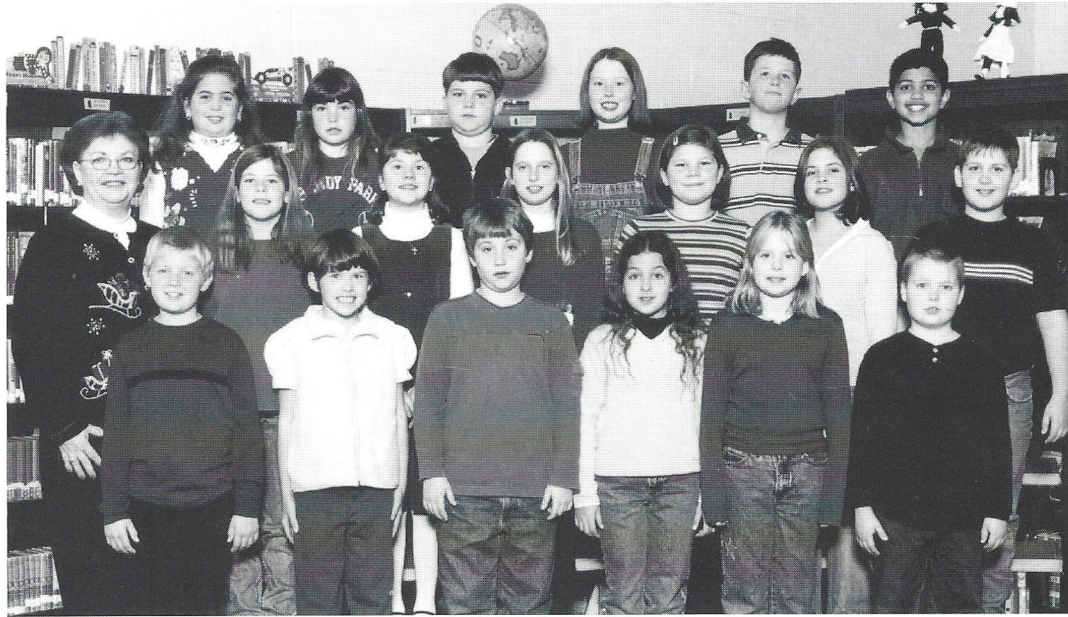


• **SIGNING THE CODE** •

• **A QUICK SMILE** •

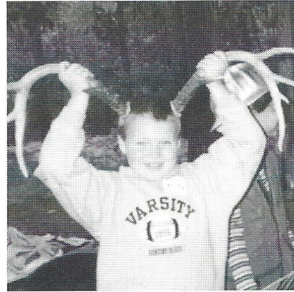
Katherine Matthews stops at the door to give us a quick smile before she goes back to her hard work. The fourth graders were always ready for fun but knew hard work had to come first.



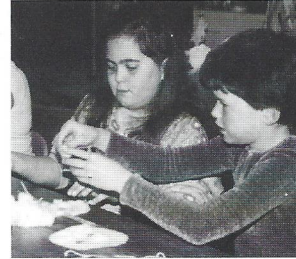
A Perfect Snowman: Dakota Weir shows off his seasonal art project to several of his classmates. Art with Mrs. Rowe was a favorite activity each week.
