

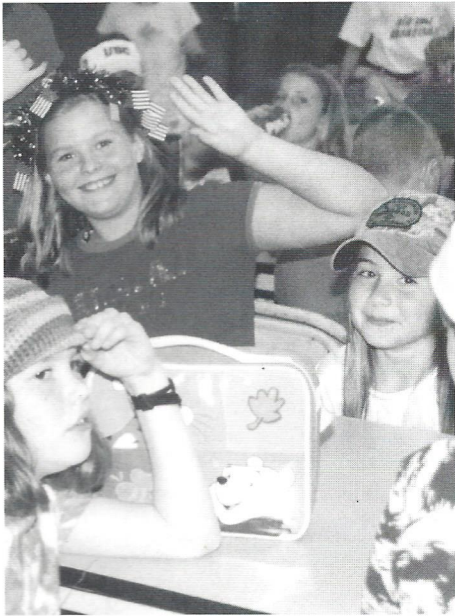
• AND THE CROWD GOES WILD •

An estatic group of fifth graders puts everything they've got into cheering for the Eagles during a pep rally. Competition between the classes often got loud and very spirited.

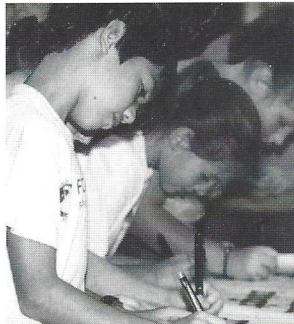


• A HAT DAY SALUTE •

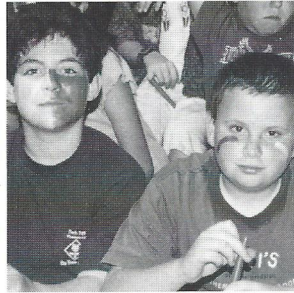

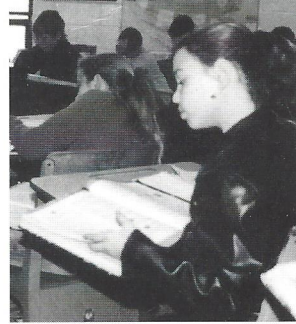
