

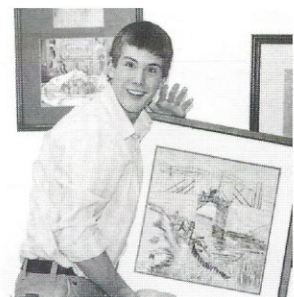

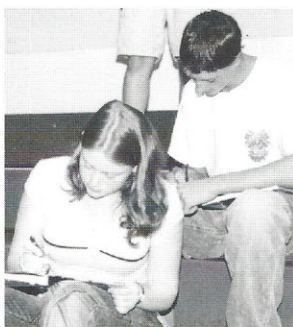
Sophomore students Holly, Pressley, Katie and Leigh sign the Eagle Code to show their support of R.W.A. It was a time for all students to make a serious commitment.

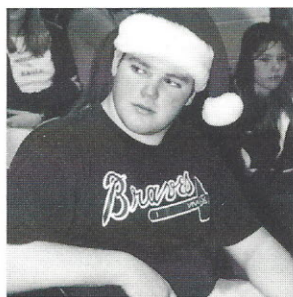

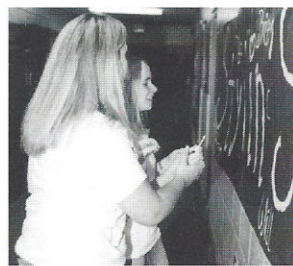

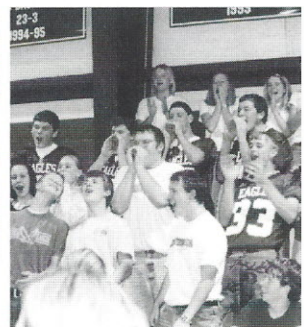
