The third graders get their music program underway by singing the National Anthem. The students also sang songs featuring the people, plants, animals, and land in South Carolina.

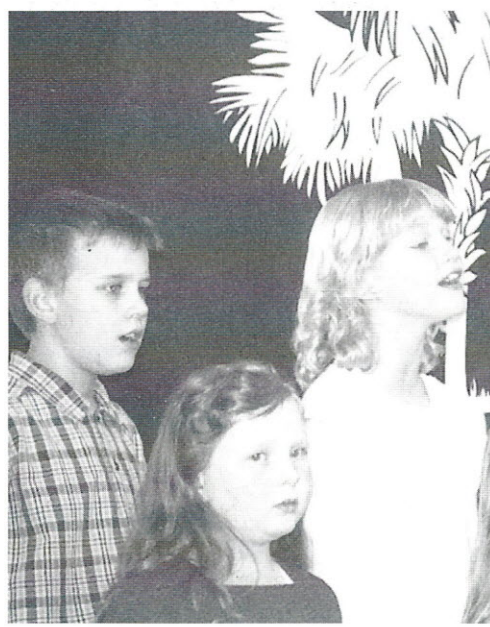
• PROUD AS A PEACOCK •
