•MONKEY IN THE MIDDLE•

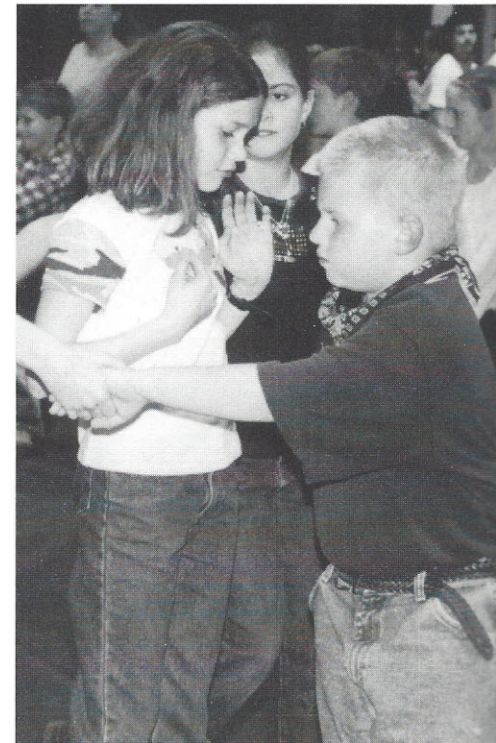
Kelly Cooper patiently waits to get out of the circle and let her partner get in. The children's eagerness to learn the dances made the dance an even bigger success.
