

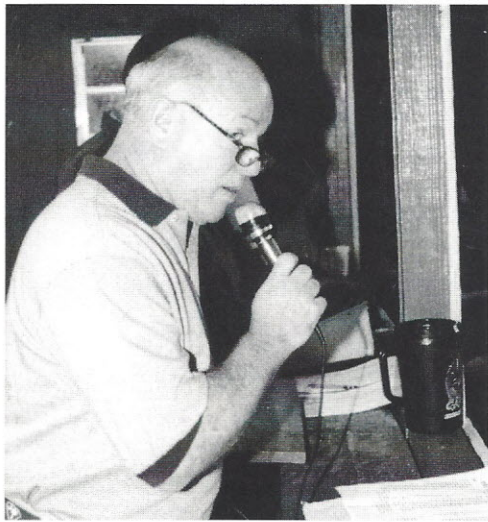
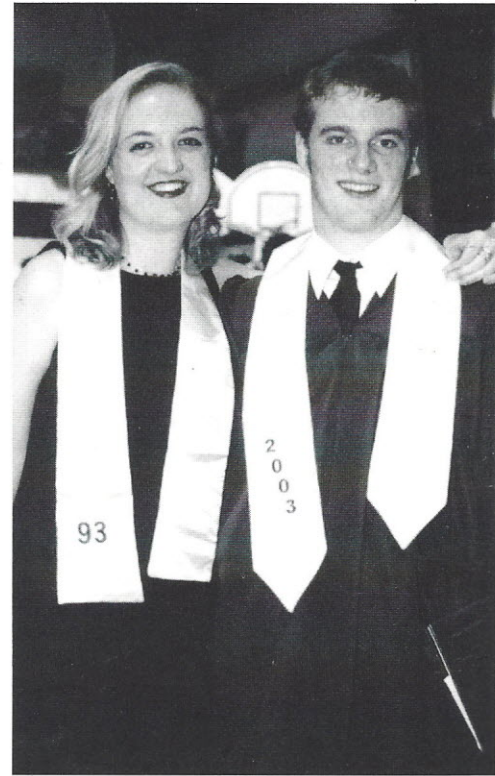
• A STANDING OVATION •

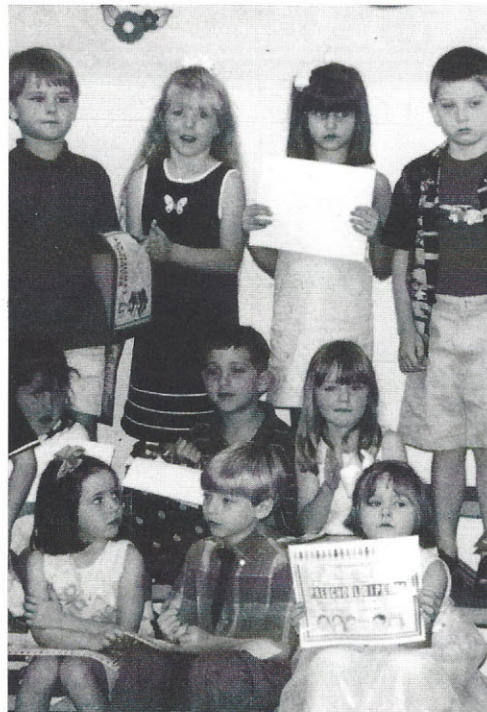
• It's A FAMILY AFFAIR •
