

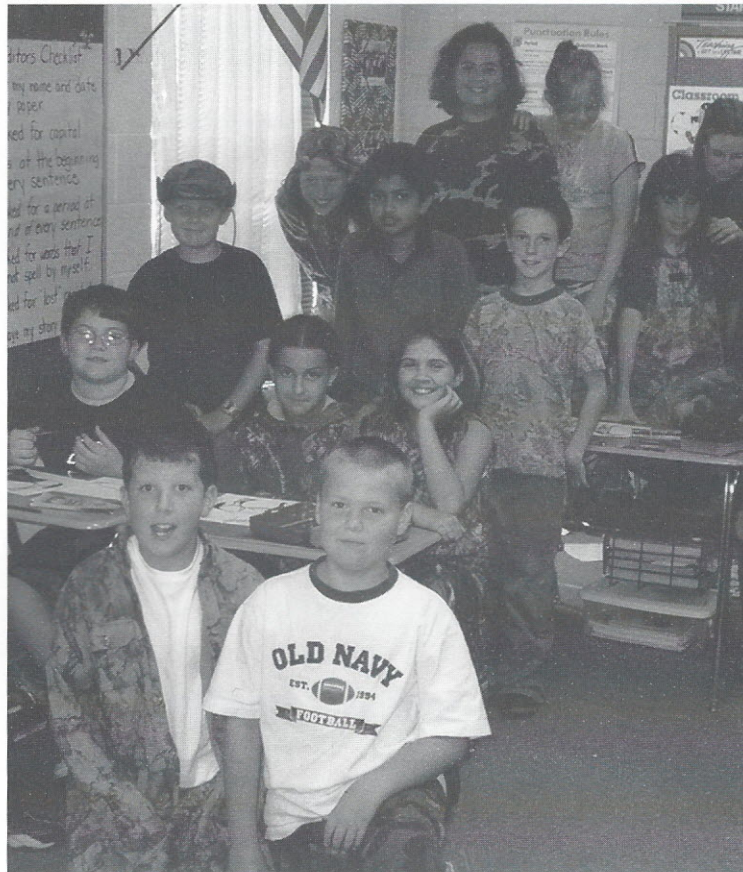

## CAN YOU SEE ME NOW?

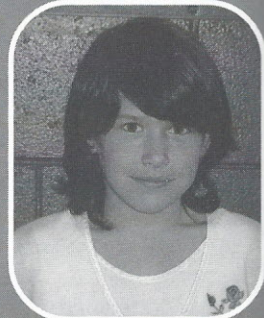
These fifth graders take a break from their busy school day to take a picture. Many students looked forward to Camouflage Day so they could get all decked out in their favorite hunting attire.

## WHAT YOU TALKIN' 'BOUT, WILLIS?

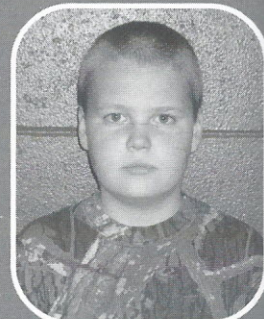
Savannah Medlin has her picture taken by surprise during her library time. Savannah, like other students, enjoyed Spirit Week and was not embarrassed to dress up to the max.
