SEEING DOUBLE

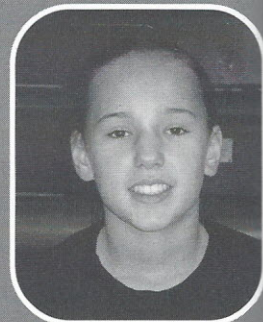
The sixth graders display their Homecoming spirit on Twin Day. Dress up days allowed them a chance to be unique and creative.
