

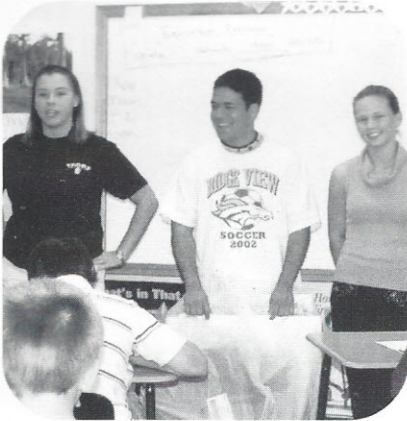
Southern Fun in the Sun
