

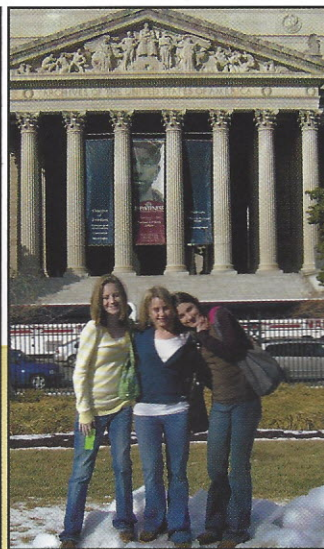
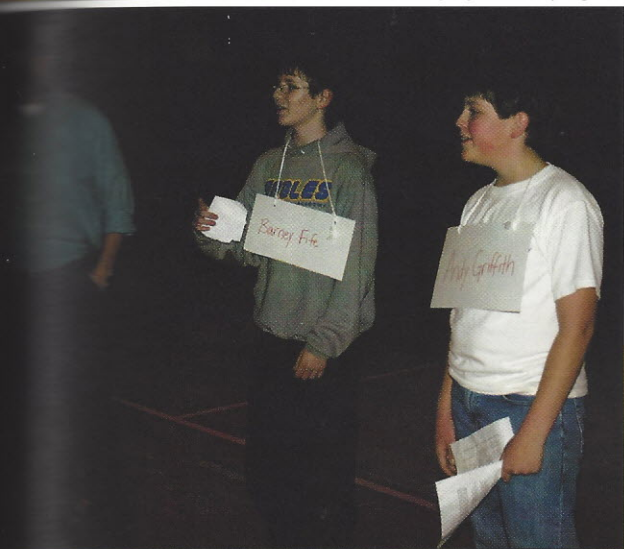


Sign That "S"!

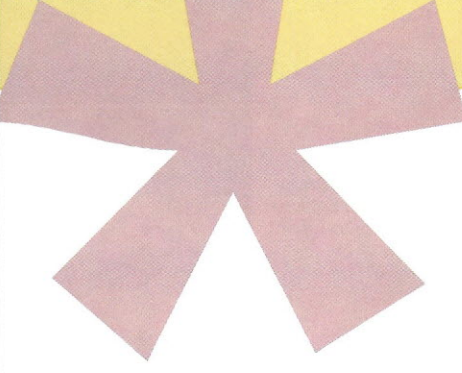
Ryan Parker

"I would give some to charity, and some to my parents and my sister. I would also buy a nice house and a truck, then I would put the rest of it in the bank and live off of the benefits."

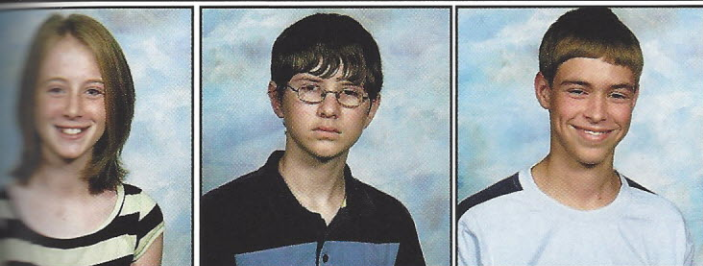


Doctors, Indians, & Lawyers, Oh My!
