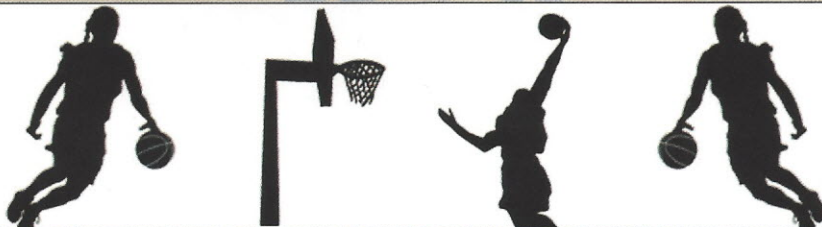


Filling in the Gaps
