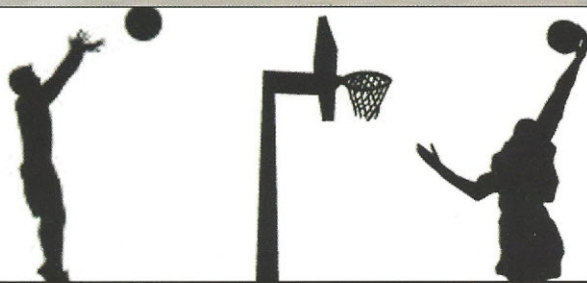


Building Blocks of Success
