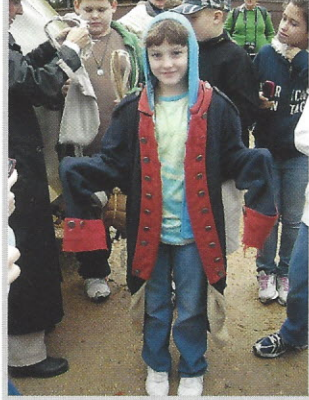


BIRTHPLACE OF A NATION
