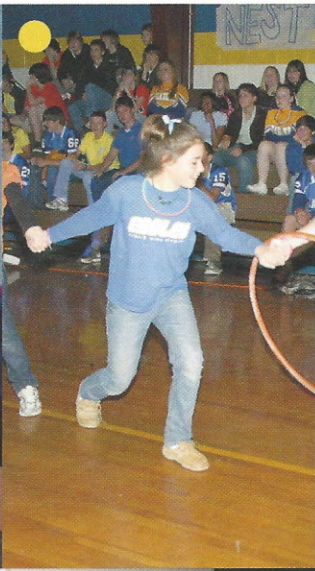


5th Grade

● Lydia participates during the Homecoming Pep Rally.

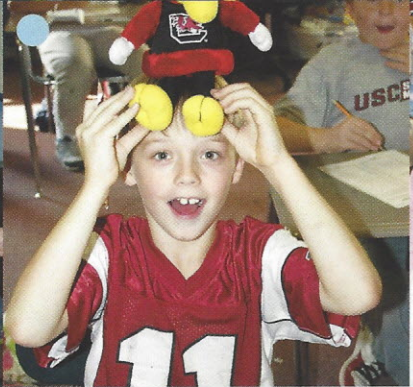
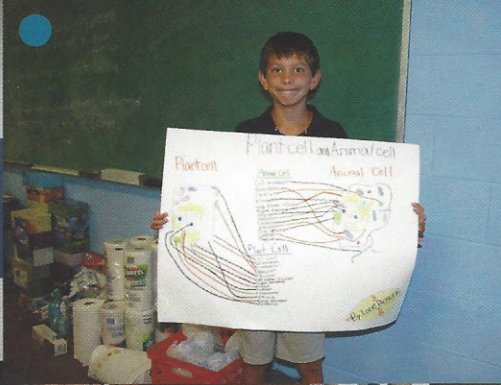
● The fifth grade class shows off their Character Day costumes.

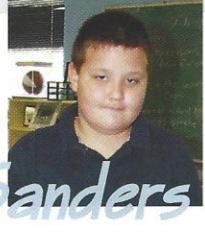

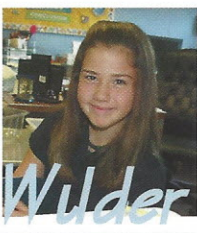
