

# SQUARE DANCE

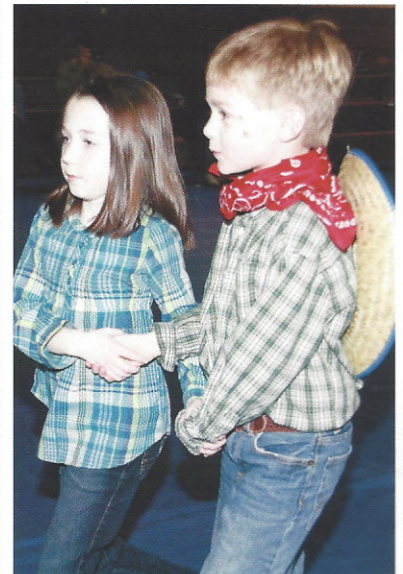
## *Supreme Family Fun!*
